GOOD NEIGHBOR FUND

The Good Neighbor Fund helps Upper Arlington residents that have a unique, unforeseen event happen in their lives that threaten their stability. This fund is specifically for one-time, emergency assistance due to an event that seriously jeopardizes the recipient's ability to meet basic needs.

**The Donor believes there is a progression of responsibility in meeting needs:**

- 1. first the individual's responsibility,**
- 2. second the individual's family,**
- 3. and last, outside resources (both public and private).**

**The GNF should not be considered as the first assistance provider to be contacted but is intended as a last resort source of funding and a one-time grant per individual or family. The Foundation will not consider requests until all other public, private, and personal/family resources have been exhausted.**

Applicants must be an Upper Arlington, Ohio resident and show proof of residency; be able to demonstrate need due to a unique unforeseen event such as illness, calamitous event or urgent circumstance that creates a hardship and threatens ability to meet basic needs such as: housing, transportation to work, medical bills, food insecurity, etc.; and must not have received Good Neighbor grant assistance in the past.

Financial grants from GNF are intended to be a one-time supplement. Grants from GNF are meant to help those people who are already on a path of recovery and who are committed to helping themselves so they can achieve changes in their lives. The Donor hopes that grants made will assist the recipient(s) in a continuation of self-help.
